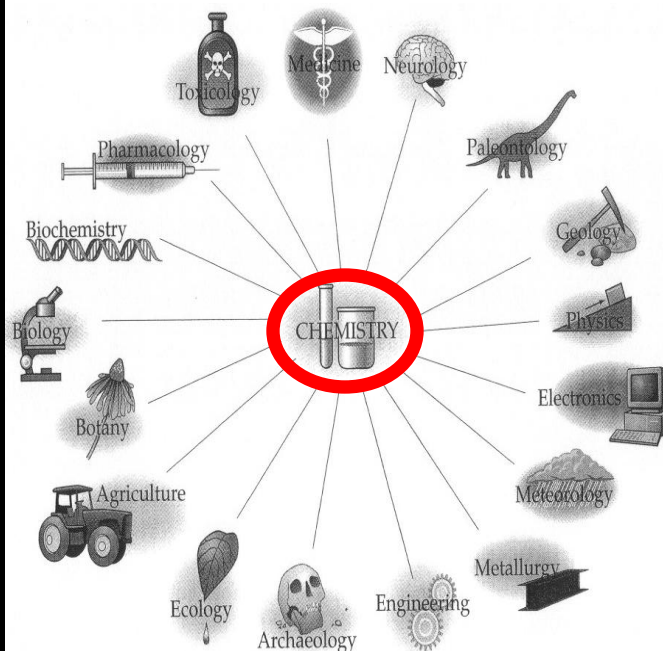
- become more informed citizens with a basic understanding of the chemical sciences
