SOAR COURSE LOCATIONS and PARKING INFORMATION for FALL 2009

On Campus Parking at SUNY Potsdam (Go to: <http://www.potsdam.edu/soar> - click on balloon to find links to interactive campus maps)

PARKING PERMIT REMINDERS: 1) Fill in your license plate number, 2) Avoid getting a ticket; park only where permitted,

3) Always **display your permit** on your rear view mirror, 4) Reuse your fall parking permit in the spring semester (*it is good through Aug. 31, 2010*).

On Campus SUNY Locations (*Mobility issues? Have someone drop you off and pick you up*):

Kellas Hall 102 (*ground floor*). Park in lots #2, # 6 (or #1, #7, #9). Enter at the archway door. 102 is at the far (Merritt Hall) end of the hall

Kellas Hall 105 (*ground floor*). – Park in lots #2, # 6 (or #1, #7, #9). Enter at archway door, turn right; 105 is two doors down the corridor.

Maxcy Hall – Park in lots #30 or #27 (**NOT** lot #29, the front row, closest to the main entrance of the building).

Dance Studio (*3rd floor*). Bear right and take first stairs on the left to 3rd floor; room is nearby (or use **elevator** at far end of the corridor.)

Field House - climbing wall (*ground floor*). Entrance to the field house is on the left as you come in the door.

Maxcy 104 (*ground floor*). After entering, stay right; go to the far end of the corridor and turn left; 104 is the first room on the right.

Maxcy 220 (*2nd floor*). Follow directions (*above*) to Maxcy 104. Go past 104 to the end of the corridor and up the stairs; 220 is on the right.

OR, after entering, stay right, go to the far end and take the elevator to 2nd floor; cross through the gym, turn right, 220 is then on the left.

Morey Hall 117 – English/Communication Conference Room (*ground floor*). Park in lot #1. Enter from archway doorway; take right corridor to the end; turn right into a short corridor of offices; 117 is at the end on the right.

Raymond Hall Dining Hall - 804 (*8th floor*) – Park in lot #1 or #2. Take the **elevator** to the top floor. Room is on the right.

Satterlee Hall 314 (*3rd floor*). Park in lots #1, #7 or #9. Take staircase or **elevator** (at either end of this middle building section) to 3rd floor.

Stowell Hall Planetarium (*basement*). Park in lots #9, #7, or #6. Enter archway door; use **elevator** at far end of corridor, or descend to basement; at end of corridor, turn left into doorway, immediate left again into a small astronomy room, and pass through it to planetarium.

Thatcher Hall (*2nd floor banquet room; fall luncheon*). Walk from lots #20 or #22, or take **car shuttle** from lot #9. **Elevator** available.

Timerman 121 (*ground floor*). Park in lots #6, #7 or #9. Enter from archway doorway, turn right to exhibit area; 121 is the second door on left.

Van Housen Extension SB27A (*ground floor*). Park in lots #22 or #20. Use the door facing the parking lots. SB27A is the first door on the right.

Off Campus Locations – Directions for locations are also posted (with pictures, where possible) with links from the individual course pages to a separate page named “Course Locations” found on the SOAR web site: <http://www.potsdam.edu/soar> (click on balloon and choose “locations” link)

Canton VFW (Meeting Room). 34 *Gouverneur* St. Head south from Canton on HWY 11; VFW is next to Stewart's. Room entrance on the side.

Glen Meal State Forest. South of Pierrepont on CR 24, ~ 0.6 miles from intersection of CR 24 and CR 29. Park on sides of CR24 or access road.

Massena Public Library (Meeting Room B - basement). 41 Glenn St. (downtown Massena, north of E. Orvis St.). Take the stairs down and follow the right corridor to Room B. Handicapped only **elevator** is at the back entrance of the building; the elevator opens into Room B.

Mayfield Apartments, Potsdam (Community Room). 22 Mayfield Drive (off May Road; in low office building in center of circle). Park **only** where you see “VISTOR” marked on the curb or in the lot beyond the circle (or park behind Save-a-Lot/Kinney's and use the sidewalk to Mayfield).

Partridge Knoll, Canton (Multi-Purpose Room). 30 Sullivan Dr. Large complex, just off intersection of State St. and Rt. 310 (near schools). Park in any spot – in front or on the side, but **NOT** on the lawn! The Multi-Purpose Room is nearest the far left entrance door to the building.

Potsdam Civic Center (Room 207 / Community Meeting Room – 2nd floor). 2 Park Street (between the Library and Museum). Park **behind** the building (or in another nearby public parking lot). **Enter at the back** using the Police Station entrance, turn right, go up a half-flight of stairs; turn left and go up another half-flight. Entrance to room is on the right. (Small **elevator** near the stairs.)

Potsdam Public Museum (main room – 2nd floor). 2 Park Street (corner nearest Main Street.). Follow Civic Center instructions (*see above*), but go up only the first half-flight of stairs (or take the **elevator**), then straight into the old section, wind your way to the front corridor that leads to museum.

NCPR, Canton (Noble Medical Building, Room 201 - 2nd floor). 80 East Main St. (Rt.11). Park in front or in the side lot behind the building; take **elevator** (or stairs) to the second floor. Room 201 (a suite of studios/offices) is on the west end of the building.

Silas Wright House, Canton (County Gallery in the Red Barn Addition). 3 East Main Street (Rt.11) (white house with picket fence, across from park). The main entrance to SWH is in the back where there is also a small parking lot. Easiest entrance to this lot is from Court St. (use the Canton Savings and Loan entrance); additional free parking is on Main Street (east of SWH) & on the far sides of the park.

SLU, Canton (Richardson Hall – Room 15). Using the “formal” entrance to SLU, park in first lot on right (Vilas Hall / Nobel Center parking lot); visitors may park anywhere but in the first 3 lines of cars (some handicap parking in first two lines). Walk up the hill to Richardson Hall (building next to the chapel). Descend 7 steps to enter a basement door (handicapped ramp is at center door); Room 15 is at the north end of the building.

South of the Rock Inn (South Colton). 3927 SH 56 (*in the center of town on the south side of the road*). Parking lot next to restaurant.

United Methodist Church, Potsdam (Sanctuary). 26 Main St. Park in the lot behind church or in the public lot off Union St.
