

DIRECTIONS TO GLENMEAL STATE FOREST ("Mushrooms and Mosses of the North Country" with Karl McKnight) ([More info and photos at:www2.potsdam.edu/soar/loc_gsf.html](http://www2.potsdam.edu/soar/loc_gsf.html))

From downtown Potsdam: Take Pierrepont Avenue (Rt.56) south, passing through Hanawa Falls. About 2 miles from the little gas/grocery store, turn right onto the Russell Turnpike Road (Rt.24). Keep going straight through Pierrepont, crossing over Rt.68, then crossing over Rt.24 (Pierrepont town barn is on your right). Glenmeal State Forest is just south of the Pierrepont town barn (on Rt. 24), about 0.6 miles from the intersection of Rt.24 and Rt.29.

From downtown Canton: Take Park Street east, passing St. Lawrence University, continuing straight (on Rt.27) at the blinking red light. Veer left (leaving Rt.27) and drive up Waterman Hill on Rt. 29. At the Pierrepont town barn (at the big orange snow plow) turn right onto Rt.24. Glenmeal State Forest is just south of the Pierrepont town barn (on Rt.24), about 0.6 miles from the intersection of Rt.24 and Rt.29.

Parking: Park on the side of the access road into the Glenmeal State Forest or park on the side of the road (Rt.24) near the entrance to the access road to the State Forest.

NOTES: There are no restroom facilities. Wear appropriate shoes/coat; bring a 7X hand lens, if possible, and a notepad. **ACCESS ROAD:** Look left (east) for a gravel road going up a hill – this is the access road. A tan Toyota Prius will be parked at the access road/Rt.24. Drive up the access road to the turn around and come back down and park on the right shoulder (**OR** park on the shoulder of Rt.24) and walk up the hill to the turnaround where we will meet Karl McKnight. Allow some extra time to park and walk up the hill (its 3/4 mile from Rt.24 to the turnaround).
