SOAR COURSE LOCATIONS & PARKING INFO for SPRING 2010

On Campus Parking at SUNY Potsdam - www2.potsdam.edu/campusmap (*link to interactive maps showing buildings & parking*)

SUNY PARKING PERMIT REMINDERS: 1) Fill in your license plate number; 2) Avoid getting a ticket - park only where permitted; 3) Always display your permit on your rear view mirror; 4) Reuse your fall parking permit in the spring semester (it is good through Aug. 31, 2010). 5) Mobility issues? Have someone drop you off and pick you up.

On Campus SUNY Locations

Flagg 162 (basement). Park in lot #1 (or #2). Enter archway corner door nearest the lot; take stairs or elevator down; computer room straight ahead.

Kellas Hall 101 (ground floor). Park in lots #2 or # 6. Enter at the archway door. 102 is at the far (Merritt Hall) end of the hallway.

Maxcy Hall. Park in lots #30 or #27 (**NOT** lot #29, the front row, closest to the main entrance of the building).

Dance Studio (3rd floor). Bear right and take first stairs on the left to 3rd floor; room is nearby (or use elevator at far end of the corridor).

Maxcy 104 (ground floor). After entering, stay right; go to the far end of the corridor and turn left; 104 is the first room on the right.

Satterlee Hall 314 (3rd floor). Park in lots #1 or #7. Take staircase or elevator (at either end of this middle building section) to 3rd floor art room.

Stowell Hall Planetarium (basement). Park in lots #7 or #9. Room is tucked away near end of building facing the Student Union; elevator nearby.

Thatcher Hall Dining Room (2nd floor). Park in lots #7 or #9 *for class*; park in #11, #12 (or #20) *for the SOAR luncheon May 27*. Elevator in far corner.

Timerman 120 & 121 (ground floor). Park in lots #6, #7 or #9. Enter from archway doorway, turn right to exhibit area; rooms are on the left.

Van Housen Extension SB27A (ground floor). Park in lots #22 or #20. Use the door facing the parking lots. SB27A is the first door on the right.

Canton Free Library (Paige Room - basement). 6 Park St. (next to post office); park on street or behind. Elevator by entrance (buzz for key).

Erin’s Isle, Hwy 11C, Brasher Falls (**Meet the Chef Event**). From Potsdam take HWY 11 north. In about 10 miles turn left onto 11C; drive through Winthrop to arrive, in a few miles, at the small downtown area of Brasher Falls. Restaurant is just over the bridge on the right.

Gouverneur Library (Community Room). 60 Church St. (far side of the park). Impressive grey stone building. Parking on street.

Knapps Station Church. From Potsdam, go north on Rt.56 to Norfolk, turn right at liquor store onto CR47; once in Knapps Station, church is on the right.

Mayfield Apartments, Potsdam (Community Room). 22 Mayfield Drive (off May Road; in low office building in center of circle). Park only where you see “VISITOR” marked on the curb or in the lot beyond the circle (or park behind Kinney’s and use the sidewalk to Mayfield).

Partridge Knoll, Canton (Multi-Purpose Room). 30 Sullivan Dr. Large complex, just off intersection of State St. and Rt. 310 (near schools). Park in front or on the side, but **NOT** on the lawn! The Multi-Purpose Room is nearest the far left entrance door to the building.

Potsdam Civic Center (Room 207 / Community Meeting Room – 2nd floor). 2 Park Street (between the Library and Museum). Park behind the building complex (or in any nearby public parking lot). Enter at the back using the Police Station entrance; turn right, go up a half-flight of stairs; turn left and go up another half-flight to the room. (There’s a small elevator near the stairs.)

St. Lawrence County Court House (Canton) - Located on Court St., Enter parking lot from Court St. Use main entrance and follow signs to courtroom.

St. Lawrence University (SLU), Canton (Bewkes Science Hall – Room 232 / 2nd floor). From downtown Canton, take Park St. to far edge of campus. Park in lot “J” (across the street from the field house). Use the Park St. entrance to Bewkes. Take staircase to second floor.

Silas Wright House, Canton (County Gallery in the Red Barn Addition). 3 East Main Street (Rt.11) (white house with picket fence, across from park). The main entrance to SWH is in the back where there is also a small parking lot. Easiest entrance to this lot is from Court St. (use the Canton Savings and Loan bank entrance); additional free parking is on Main Street (east of SWH) and on the far sides of the park.
