Soprano Kathleen Roland is a highly regarded concert soloist well known for her interpretation of the music of the 20th and 21st century. She has been a featured singer with many music festivals, including the Santa Fe Chamber Music Festival, the Britten-Pears Institute and the Tanglewood Music Festival, and will sing Cambodian born composer Chinary Ung's Aura in New York City, San Diego and Thailand this year. She is a Senior Fulbright scholar, and an American-Scandinavian Foundation grantee. Her anthology of Swedish art song for English-speaking singers is due to be published by Gehrmans Musikförlag in August of 2013. She holds a doctorate in voice from the University of Southern California, and serves on the board of the National Opera Association. Dr. Roland joined the faculty of Setnor School of Music last fall, where she teaches voice, vocal literature, diction and vocal pedagogy.
