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SUNY Potsdam is on the cutting edge of having the latest and best equipment and staff available to help their student athletes reach their full potential!

SUNY Potsdam recently made a major investment towards the improving the health and wellness of its campus community by significantly upgrading cardio and weight equipment in the Shane T. Shaul Fitness Center.

Students now have numerous fitness options to pursue within the center, including both free weight stations and a Cybex Eagle circuit as well as 38 new cardio machines, including: 10 Precor Teadmills, 10 Precor Ellipticals, 6 Cybex Arc Trainers, 2 Precor Steppers, 3 Precor Upright Bikes, 3 Precor Recumbent Bikes, 3 First Degree Fluid Rowers and 1 ScitFit Pro1 Upper Body Ergometer.

"Cardio Entertainment" is integrated into 34 of the 38 cardio stations. A personal viewing screen (PVS) allows users to choose and watch their favorite show via the campus cable network during their workout! Headphones from any portable music device can be used on the units with the PVS option.

In addition to the fitness center's new equipment, a full-time fitness director and a well-trained staff are available to help design individualized workout routines and to ensure a safe and clean facility. Numerous group fitness classes are available throughout the year.

Men's Lacrosse Coaching Staff



RICK BERKMAN - HEAD COACH

Rick Berkman, the 2007 SUNYAC Coach of the Year, recently completed his thirteenth season as the head coach of the men's lacrosse program at SUNY Potsdam. During Berkman's tenure the Bears have had eight winning seasons, eleven post-season appearances, a conference championship and amassed an impressive 43-34 mark in conference play.

In 1997, Berkman was named Empire Lacrosse League "Coach of the Year" after guiding Potsdam to its first-ever Empire Lacrosse League championship. He also took the Bears to the first of eleven post-season appearances in 1995.

Coach Berkman was named the 1998 USLCA (Unites States Lacrosse Coaches Association) "Man of the Year". Berkman was recognized for his contributions to the growth of lacrosse in the North Country. He has organized several lacrosse clinics, tournaments and youth leagues since his arrival to Potsdam.

In 1999, the Bears reached the ECAC (Eastern College Athletic Conference) Championship game and came within one goal of winning their first postseason title.

Potsdam set a school record for wins in 2000 with 10 and was also an ECAC semi-finalist reaching the post-season for the fourth consecutive year.

From 2001 through 2005, the Bears finished in fourth place in their SUNYAC conference which qualified them for post-season action each year. Potsdam faced SUNY Cortland each year from '01 through '05 when they lost close first round tournament games. In 2007 the men finished 3rd before losing to Geneseo in the SUNYAC and RIT in the ECAC.

Berkman also serves as a Physical Education Instructor at SUNY Potsdam and is on the NCAA Lacrosse Advisory Committee. He also coaches the Men's Varsity Golf team.

Prior to Potsdam Berkman served as assistant coach at Salisbury State, where he helped guide the Seagulls to three consecutive NCAA tournaments and their first NCAA National Championship in 1994.

As a player for the Seagulls, Berkman led the team to a National Championship appearance in 1991 only to fall one goal short to eventual champion Hobart College. That season he was named a first team All-American and captained his team in the prestigious North/South game.

Coach Berkman his wife Jessica and their son Tyler reside in the village of Potsdam. The Berkman's are expecting the birth of their second child this spring.

BEN GAEBEL - ASSISTANT COACH

Ben Gaebel joined the SUNY Potsdam community last fall as an assistant coach for both men's lacrosse and men's golf. His lacrosse responsibilities are focused primarily upon coaching the defense and goalies. Ben is also heavily involved with player recruiting.

Coach Gaebel also works in many lacrosse camps and clinics including those at: Lemoyne, Hobart, Syracuse, Carthage, and Syracuse University. Additionally Ben has worked in the Powell Brothers Lacrosse Camps.

A 2006 graduate of SUNY Cortland, Gaebel was an All-American goalie for the Red Dragons and starting goalie of their '06 National Champion team. Ben was also named to the All-SUNYAC team in both 2005 and 2006. He finished at Cortland with a major in Athletic Training.

Prior to his illustrious college lacrosse career, Ben was an All-Northern goalie at Carthage High School. He was named a Frontier League All-Star in both 2001 and 2002. During his tenure at Carthage, his team twice finished as runner-ups for the New York State Championship. Gaebel also played varsity basketball for two years and football for three years

2008 Men's Lacrosse Season Outlook

The Bears finished the 2007 season third in the conference with a record of 4-2. The team advanced to the SUNYAC Playoffs as the third seed where they lost to Geneseo 14-8 in the semi-finals. The Bears also were selected to participate in the ECAC Tournament where they fell to a strong RIT team 14-7 in the semi-finals.

The '08 team will face some big non-conference games against RPI, Clarkson and SLU. The team will also be home for several big games including SUNYAC match-ups with Oneonta, Plattsburgh and Cortland.

Attack

This year's attack will be have to replace 2nd Team SUNYAC All-Star and captain Matt Vaverchak who was the teams second leading scorer a year ago and a four year starter for the Bears. Although the departure of Vaverchak is a big one, the team returns four veterans who gained valuable experience a year ago.

Returning to the starting line-up are sophomores Kyle Phelix (14g,8a) and Justin Wilson-Kirby (14g,2a). Phelix is the main ball carrier and set-up man while Kirby is a strong finisher and shooter from the outside. Jordan Joncas(3g) is a lefty who will look to fill the third spot or help the Bears on the man-up team. Evan Sovring is a strong attackman who plays on the crease and will look to contribute this year.

The Bears attack will also feature three freshman: Cody Schroeder, Kevin Green and Garrett Sharp. Each of these rookies had successful high school careers and will look to earn their way into the starting line-up.

Offensive Midfield

The offensive midfield unit will be lead by six veterans and one transfer who have all gained valuable experience over the past two seasons. Leading the unit will be junior Corey Reinhart (25g,12a) who was a SUNYAC 2nd Team All-Star and the teams Offensive MVP in '07. Corey is a very strong offensive middle who possesses a very hard shot and excellent dodging ability. Also returning to the midfield are senior George Nolan (5g,18a) and junior captain Conor O'Neil (10g,7a). Nolan is one of the Bears primary set-up men and best dodgers while O'Neil is a dangerous threat shooting the ball from the outside.

The Bears also return three other veterans: Nik Bryan (3g,3a), Sean Sawyer (1g) and face-off specialist and captain Chris Kowalczyk (53%). Zac McIlmoyle is a transfer who comes to the program from Peterborough, Ontario and should fit into the Bears offense as an immediate impact player.

Seven promising freshman: Sam Dutkowsky, Braden Gallant, Dustin Dunn, Jordan Manzer, Mike Elsworth, Joe Stanley and Kyle Green are all very solid players who will push for playing time as freshman.

Defensive Midfield

The defensive midfield unit will be lead by three returners who all had excellent seasons a year ago and were key to the Bears playoff run in '07. Junior Ryan McHugh and sophomores Ben McCullough ('07 Co-Freshman of the Year) and Andy Deer ('07 Most Improved) are the veterans that will lead a very athletic defense from the midfield position. McCullough and Deer are the returning starters who both possess excellent speed and toughness in the middle of the field. McHugh is a very capable athlete who will look to push for a starting spot in '08. Two freshman: Jemray Reape and Brad Galante will add size and strength to the defensive midfield position.

The long-stick midfield position will be led by one senior and three sophomores. Senior Ryan Puvogel will look to lead the group with his aggressive play in between the lines. Sophomore Dan MacRae ('07 Co-Freshman of the Year and '08 SUNYAC Pre-Season 1st Team Selection) has worked very hard in the off-season and will look to dominate the middle of the field for Potsdam. The Bears also have transfer Rob Schloop who had an outstanding fall season and now seems ready to make an impact for the team. Dave Blackburn (56%) is the fourth long pole who makes his impact at the face-off position.

Defense

The defensive unit returns three starters from a year ago and a few returners who will give the Bears added depth and experience at the position. Leading the unit are senior Brett Wetzel and junior captain AJ Lalonde who was a 2nd Team SUNYAC All-Star and the teams Defensive MVP in '07. Wetzel is a very good one on one defender and shut down player while Lalonde plays a very physical and intimidating style of defense with the ability to take the ball away at any time. The third returning starter is sophomore Brogin VanSkoik who brings a combination of toughness and athleticism to help shut down the opposition.

Also returning to the defense after missing the '07 season due to injury is junior James Mulligan who was a 1st Team SUNYAC All-Star in'05 and a 2nd teamer in '06. James will look to step right into the starting rotation and give the Bears experience and leadership on defense. Two other veterans: junior captain Steve Tristan and senior Joe Nichols will look to earn their way into the Bears defensive line-up. Along with a talented and experienced defense the team welcomes in two very highly touted freshman in Nich Sansone and Tyler Pound.

Goal

In goal the Bears will have to replace Brian Hondorf who was a 1st Team SUNYAC All-Star and the team MVP in '07. Looking to fill that spot will be sophomore Billy Richards who gained valuable experience in '07 and looks poised to assume the duties this year. Billy is a very athletic goalie who is capable of making the big save and getting the transition game started with his outlet passes. Three highly recruited freshman: Chris Ehde, Kalvin Thomas and Pat Corbine will look to push for the starting position.

The SUNY Potsdam athletic facilities are centered around and within Maxcy Hall. The multimillion dollar facility was built in 1971 and has undergone several major revisions since then. It is considered one of the finest sports complexes in the country.

At the heart of Maxcy is the Bears' 2,500 seat ice arena, as well as, the 3,600 seat Jerry Welsh Gymnasium. Maxcy also houses a natatorium with an Olympic-sized swimming pool and a 33,000 square foot fieldhouse.

On the buildings third floor is the 8000 square foot Shane T. Shaul Fitness Center which was completely remodeled this fall.

Fifty acres of athletic fields surround Maxcy including the recently build all-weather Astroturf N field. The turf field serves as the home for both lacrosse and soccer events.

A new women's softball field was also recently added while the tennis courts have been completely remodeled to include lights and a new court surface.
