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Athletic Facilities

The SUNY Potsdam athletic facilities are centered around and within Maxcy Hall. The multimillion dollar facility was built in 1971 and has undergone several major revisions since then. It is considered one of the finest sports complexes in the country.


At the heart of Maxcy is the Bears' 2,500 seat ice arena, as well as, the 3,600 seat Jerry Welsh Gymnasium. Maxcy also houses a natatorium with an Olympic-sized swimming pool and a 33,000 square foot fieldhouse.

On the buildings third floor is the 8000 square foot Shane T. Shaul Fitness Center which was completely remodeled this fall.

Fifty acres of athletic fields surround Maxcy including the recently build all-weather Astroturf N field. The turf field serves as the home for both lacrosse and soccer events.

A new women's softball field was also recently added while the tennis courts have been completely remodeled to include lights and a new court surface.

JOE VAADI - HEAD COACH

Head Coach Joe Vaadi is now entering his fourteenth year at the helm of the BSUNY Potsdam men's soccer team. Coach Vaadi is a graduate of South Jefferson High School in Adams, New York where he played varsity soccer.

After completing high school, Vaadi came to SUNY Potsdam where he played soccer for two years. Coach Vaadi is a 1988 graduate of Potsdam with a Bachelors Degree in History.

After bringing in two of the largest men's soccer recruiting classes in college history, Coach Vaadi now continues to build and improve upon the program. His 2002 men's team earned a SUNYAC berth which was the first playoff berth in school history.

Vaadi's success with Bears soccer

program also resulted in his being named the 2000 SUNYAC Men's Soccer Coach of the Year.





Damien Jepson - Assistant Coach

Damien Jepson will begin his first season of coaching with the SUNY Potsdam Bears this fall. He is a 2008 graduate of SUNYIT where he earned a Bachelors of Science Degree in Business. He previously earned an Associates Degree from Adirondack Community College in 2006.

In addition to four years playing college soccer, Damien has coached 4th grade, modified, and U-19 teams. He was also a men's soccer Gold Medalist in the 2007 Empire State Games.

Damien will be counted on to "hit the road" and be in charge of recruiting. Jepson will also assist with daily team practice, as well as participating in game day coaching.

SUNY Potsdam Men Welcome Twelve Newcomers

Longtime men's soccer coach Joe Vaadi, now entering his 14th year at the SUNY Potsdam helm, will welcome twelve returners as the Bears open their 2009 season. The Potsdam roster will also include thirteen new players including seven freshmen.

The veterans are led by forward Dylan Reed. Reed topped the team's scoring stats last year with eight goals and one assist for 17 points. He will be joined in the field by seniors Brandon Kelley, Matt Rudd, juniors Tim Ciampa,

and Jon Reeves.

"We will be more defensive this year and use more of a team defense," Vaadi said. "We are a lot deeper than we have ever been." Kelley and sophomore Chris Mack will both be anchors of the defense and will be joined by senior Ryan McAssey.

Freshmen contributions will include midfielder Zack LaDue who scored 30 goals and had 50 assists while playing at Cohoes High School.

Rookie goalkeeper Joseph Glackin, a Shaker High School standout, will see the most time between the pipes. Backing him up will be fellow freshman Colin MacIver.

Other Potsdam newcomers include Christopher Riddell and Mario Balzano at midfield, Conor Harold at forward, and Sean Atkinson and Victor Colasacco on defense

The Bears will be looking to improve on last year's 4-13-2 record. Besides improvements on defense, Vaadi sees improvement on offense too. "Offensively we will be a lot better and be more controlled and in sync," he said.

The men will play their season opener On September 1st down in Utica against SUNYIT before heading over to Canton for the 2009 Lotto Classic a few days later. In the Lotto, the men will face arch-rivals Clarkson and St. Lawrence. The Bears will play their home opener on September 9th when they welcome SUNY Canton.

SUNY Potsdam is on the cutting edge of having the latest and best equipment and staff available to help their student athletes reach their full potential!

SUNY Potsdam recently made a major investment towards the improving the health and wellness of its campus community by significantly upgrading cardio and weight equipment in the Shane T. Shaul Fitness Center.

Students now have numerous fitness options to pursue within the center, including both free weight stations and a Cybex Eagle circuit as well as 38 new cardio machines, including: 10 Precor Teadmills, 10 Precor Ellipticals, 6 Cybex Arc Trainers, 2 Precor Steppers, 3 Precor Upright Bikes, 3 Precor Recumbent Bikes, 3 First Degree Fluid Rowers and 1 ScitFit Pro1 Upper Body Ergometer.

"Cardio Entertainment" is integrated into 34 of the 38 cardio stations. A personal viewing screen (PVS) allows users to choose and watch their favorite show via the campus cable network during their workout! Headphones from any portable music device can be used on the units with the PVS option.

In addition to the fitness center's new equipment, a full-time fitness director and a well-trained staff are available to help design individualized workout routines and to ensure a safe and clean facility. Numerous group fitness classes are available throughout the year.
